CAT CARE AGREEMENT

I understand that....

WWAH will make the final decision about whether a certain animal is available for adoption.

WWAH recommends strongly against declawing because it is painful for the cat and often leads to other behavior problems.

WWAH will not adopt a kitten/cat to me if I plan to let it outdoors.

All cats/kittens adopted from WWAH will be altered to prevent over population and to protect the cat's health. If I select a cat/kitten that is not altered, I will sign a Spay/Neuter Contract prior to adopting the cat/kitten.

WWAH will not adopt a pet to be a surprise gift form someone else. The person receiving the animal MUST be present at the time of adoption.

I will pay an adoption fee for any cat(s) adopted and I will be responsible for *all* costs related to the cat/kitten after adoption.

I will need to take my new pet to my own veterinarian within 10 days of adoption for a full evaluation and to arrange for additional boosters and parasite control.

I am willing to accept certain risks that come with adopting a cat from a rescue facility....

WWAH does not know the medical, vaccination, or genetic history of the animals. A cat may have been exposed to disease or have genetic problems that the haven is unable to detect.

Although WWAH conducts a "temperament evaluation" on all cats prior to adoption, the evaluation *cannot* predict future behavior and cannot test for all possible triggers for aggression or other behavior problems.

WWAH will advise me about *known* behavioral or medical issues that a cat has shown but *cannot* guarantee the medical or behavioral health of any adopted cat or kitten.

WWAH and my neighbors expect, and I agree, that....

1. I will provide everything my new cat needs throughout his/her life (cats can live to be 14-20 years old), including fresh water, nutritious food, companionship, proper shelter, acceptable places to scratch and play.
2. I will provide flea & tick prevention and regular veterinary care.
3. I will make sure my cat is always wearing current, accurate, and visible identification (i.e.-collars and tags).
4. I will provide a safe indoor environment for my cat/kitten.
5. I will abide by all state and local laws regarding cats where I live, including requirements for rabies vaccinations and pet registration/licensing, as well as any "nuisance" laws or rules.
6. I will be responsible for risks and liabilities associated with my cat, including bites, fights or damage caused by the animal.
7. I will protect my cat when traveling by always using a safe cat carrier, and by never leaving him/her in a parked car when it is over 65 degrees outside.
8. I will take my cat to a licensed veterinarian within 10 days of adoption, and at least once each year after adoption for check-ups and vaccinations.
9. I will contact WWAH first to see if space is available for me to return the adopted animal if I can no longer keep him/her; however, I understand that I am completely responsible for finding a safe and caring new home should this occur.
